This puppy is, to the best of the breeder's knowledge, a healthy puppy when sold to the new owner. The breeder gives the new owners 48 hours from the time of receipt of the puppy to have a health examination. If not satisfied with the result of the health exam, the new owner may return the puppy, at his own expense, to the breeder for a full refund of the purchase price. A written statement from the examining veterinarian must accompany the puppy and any claim for refund must be verified by the breeder's veterinarian, at the new owner's expense, if the breeder requests.

Necessary shots and wormings are up to date, and the new owner will be expected to finish the puppy series, and then vaccinate or titer and worm according to the reading material sent and veterinary recommendations. If due to hereditary reasons the puppy should become incapable of functioning as a companion animal, the breeder will replace it from the first litter available at no replacement fee. The owner may also choose to have the dog replaced at another time in the future with the understanding that it is possible that the breeder may no longer be

breeding at that future date making replacement impossible. The companion agreement is valid for one year from the date of the contract. The owner should notify the breeder if any serious health concerns regardless of the dog's age, as under certain circumstances, the dog may still be replaced even after the year time period has expired.

All puppies sold to companion homes are sold with an A.K.C. limited registration. The puppy is to be spayed or neutered after it has reached sexual maturity unless otherwise specified below. If the dog is ever bred in the future, the replacement option is voided.

The owner agrees to:

1. not allow the dog to get overweight
2. keep the puppy on an adult dog food not to exceed 26% protein
3. not roadwork or run with the dog until at least 18 months of age and a hip examination has been performed
4. keep the dog in a contained area or on leash to prevent accidents
5. keep the dog as an inside house pet
6. not breed the dog
5. keep identification tags on the dog
6. spay or neuter the dog at an agreed upon age (see information in packet)

Not complying with any of the above stipulations voids the contract. If the dog is ever neglected, abused, or bred without the breeder's consent, the dog can be repossessed by the breeder.

The breeder asks that should the puppy's home not work out at some time in the future, the breeder will be notified, given right of first refusal on the dog, and be consulted in finding an appropriate new placement for the dog. Both the owner and breeder agree to keep each other apprised of address changes throughout the life of the dog. The owner should notify the breeder if the dog is ever stolen, lost, or upon death of the dog.
